THE 1978 SUMMER COMMENCEMENT procession will begin at 7 p.m. Friday at Baldwin Hall. Charles C. Campbell, assistant dean of the Extension Division of the University of Missouri-Columbia, will give the Commencement address at 7:30 p.m. at Stokes Stadium. Music will be provided by the University Summer Band directed by graduate assistant Tim Baldwin, and Dr. Dale Jorgenson, head of the Fine Arts Division, will lead the singing of the school song. President Charles McClain will confer degrees on approximately 400 undergraduates and graduate students. In case of rain, Commencement activities will be held in Pershing Arena.
