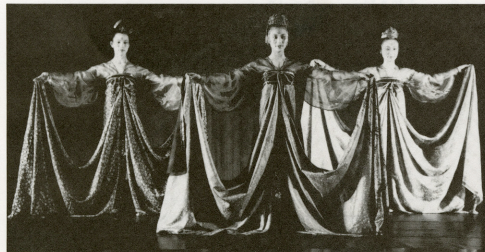
1990 Chinese Youth Goodwill Mission
