PRE-ENROLLED STUDENTS

Please note that all students who pre-registered and are awaiting financial aid (BEOG, SEOG, NDSL, Nursing Loans, Nursing Scholarships, and LEEP) must pick up their checks at the loan table outside the Business Office in the A/H Building on Monday, January 8 and proceed to the cashiers for fee payment. YOU WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO PICK UP YOUR PACKET AND PAY FEES IN VIOLETTE HALL.

Students on ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIPS must obtain the validation form from the Athletic Office and present that form to the cashiers on January 8. YOU WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO PICK UP YOUR PACKET AND PAY FEES IN VIOLETTE HALL.

All institutional scholarships not credited during pre-registration will be assessed in the Financial Aids Office (A/H 100) on January 8.

Students receiving VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION benefits for fees and/or any other necessary school expenses should obtain a form from the Financial Aids Office giving them credit for the authorized amounts.
